Hospice & Palliative Care Campus

FirstHealth Hospice & Palliative Care is a not-for-profit agency dedicated to providing compassionate, quality care for persons with life-limiting illness. FirstHealth Hospice is the only hospice affiliated with FirstHealth of the Carolinas. The focal point of the campus is the 11-bed FirstHealth Hospice House, which provides end-of-life care for patients who need more acute medical care than can be provided in the home. Patients and their families are cared for in a comfortable, home-like setting with private rooms and features such as a family kitchen, dining area and a children's play area. Patients are attended by an inter-disciplinary team consisting of physicians, nurses, social workers, counselors, nurse aides, chaplains and specially trained support volunteers.

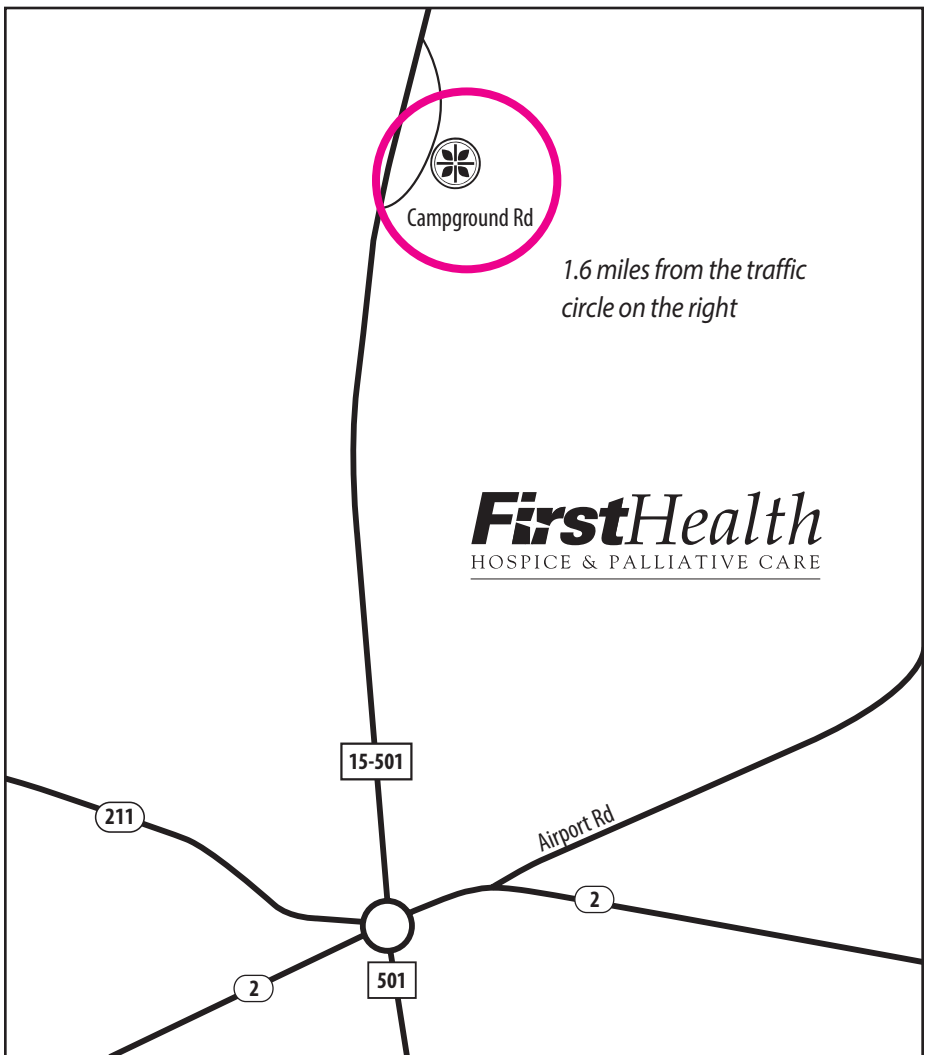
Located on a 30-acre site just minutes away from Moore Regional Hospital, the Hospice campus also includes a chapel as well as a building housing the FirstHealth Grief Resource & Counseling Center and Hospice Administration.

How and where does FirstHealth Hospice & Palliative Care serve?

FirstHealth Hospice & Palliative Care staff also continue to serve patients in their homes, in nursing homes (centers) and assisted living facilities, as well as at the Hospice House. Patients may be referred to FirstHealth Hospice by anybody, including family members and friends, and are admitted to the program with the approval of their physician.
