Digital Mammography



Clarity

To aid in the early detection of breast cancer, the digital mammography systems at FirstHealth of the Carolinas provide clearer images of breast tissue than traditional X-ray mammograms. Physicians view the electronic images of the breast on special high-resolution monitors that allow them to adjust the brightness and contrast of the image and to zoom in for close-up views of any areas of concern.

Speed

The digital system produces mammogram images in a matter of seconds. There is no waiting for film to develop, so patients may spend less time in the mammography suite.

Safety

Because digital mammography reduces the need for re-takes due to under-exposed or over-exposed images, fewer patients need to have more than the minimum amount of X-ray exposure.

Personal care

The Imaging departments at FirstHealth are staffed by experienced mammography technologists who provide one-on-one patient care and education.
