

# Face to Face Assessment of a Violent Restraint Patient

CMS requires that all patients placed in a violent restraint, **MUST** have a face to face within 1 hour...



*When restraint (physical/chemical) or seclusion is used to manage violent or self-destructive behavior that jeopardizes the immediate physical safety of the patient, staff member or others, a physician or other QLP shall see the patient face-to-face **within** 1- hour after the initiation of the intervention to evaluate:*

- (1) The patient's immediate situation;
- (2) The patient's reaction to the intervention;
- (3) The patient's medical and behavioral condition; and,
- (4) The need to continue or terminate the restraint or seclusion.
