- Individual with clinical risk factor(s) for progression to severe disease

Immunocompromising conditions – Active treatment for solid tumor or hematologic malignancy, receipt of solid-organ transplant and taking immunosuppressive therapy, receipt of CAR-T or hematopoietic stem cell transplant (within 2 years of transplant and taking immunosuppressive therapy), moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency, advanced or untreated HIV infection, active treatment with immunosuppressive therapy (high-dose corticosteroids, alkylating agents, antimetabolites, or chemotherapeutic agents classified as severely immunosuppressive), transplant-related immunosuppressive drugs, tumor-necrosis (TNF) blockers or other biologic agents that are immunosuppressive or immunomodulatory or other condition or treatment that may result in moderate to severe immune compromise

Clinical risk factors – Obesity, chronic lung disease, chronic renal disease, heart failure, CAD, chronic liver disease
