- Outpatient intravenous antibiotic therapy
- Complicated skin and soft tissue infections
- Osteomyelitis
- Joint and prosthetic joint infections
- Recurrent or resistant urinary tract infections
- Fevers of unknown origin
- Tuberculosis and atypical mycobacterial infections
- Complicated pneumonia/pulmonary infections
- CNS infections including meningitis
- Suspected travel-acquired and exotic infections

In addition, physicians can refer any patient for whom they feel an evaluation by an infectious diseases specialist is indicated. After seeing a patient, our physicians promptly communicate with the referring physician and coordinate treatment and follow-up as needed.

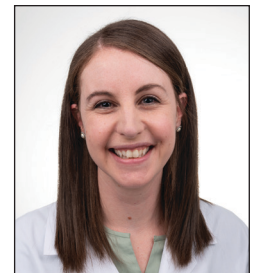

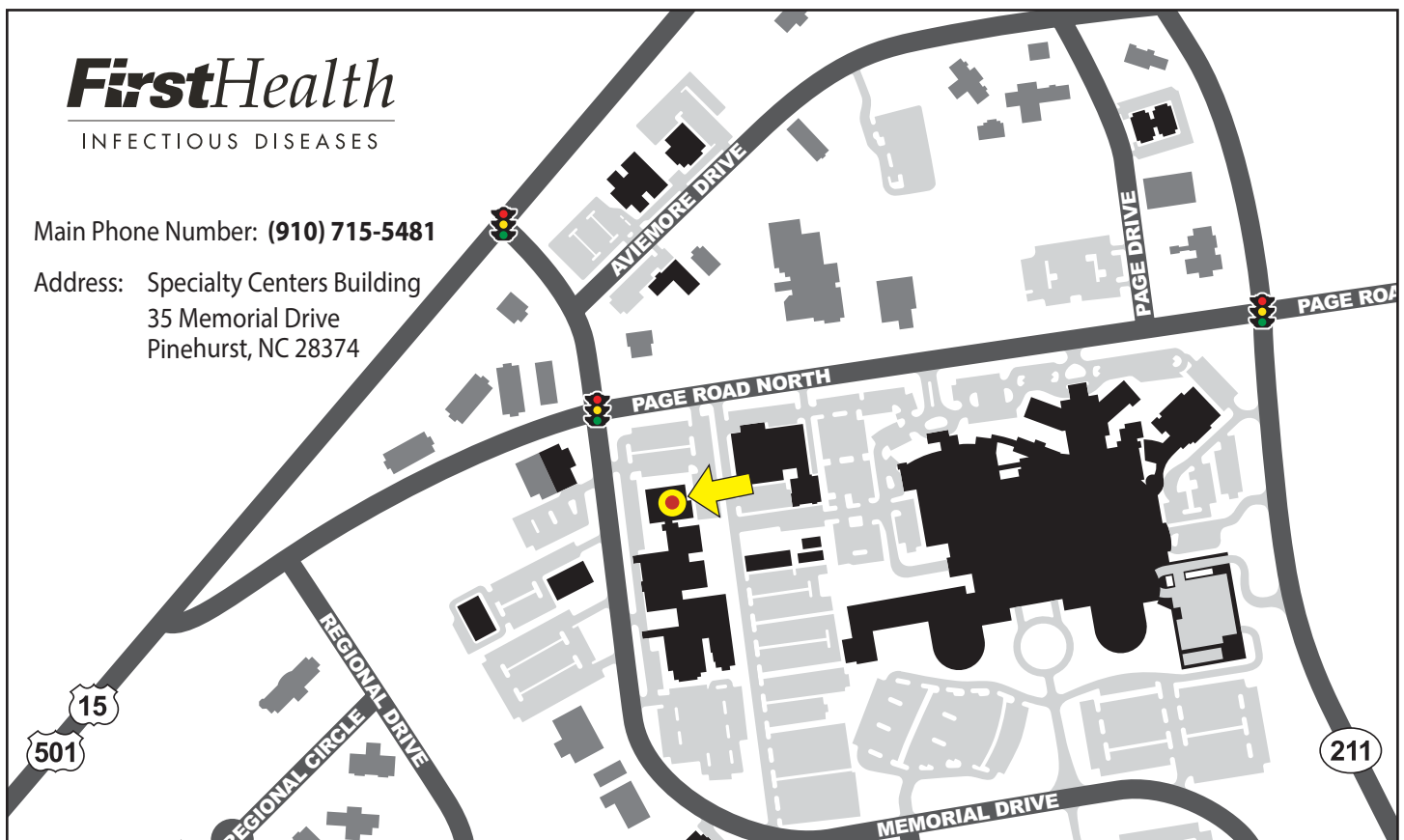
